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ATTENTION ALL MOTORCYCLISTS! The 1954 edition of the Corduroy Enduro will be a gala weekend rally to which all motorcycle enthusiasts, their families and friends are invited. Check the programme outlined below and you will agree that this is one event that you can't afford to miss. Better still, organize a club run to Gold Rock Lodge to cheer on your club members in the event and participate in the weekend's activities.

PROGRAMME

Location

Gold Rock Lodge on highway #35, four and a half miles north of Cobocnk, 100 miles from Toronto.

Friday Night

9:30 p.m. - Check in at Gold Rock Lodge

10:00 p.m. - Riders' meeting

9:30 - 12:00 p.m. - Refreshments (wet and dry).

- Colour films and slides of motorcycle events, including the 1953 Corduroy Enduro.
- Finnish Steam Bath and Swim.

Saturday

7:00 a.m. - Breakfast

8:00 a.m. - First rider leaves. Saturday's route covers 260 miles of secondary roads and lumber trails in the Haliburton-Bancroft region. Spectators will be directed by main roads to points of interest on the route.

6:00 - 7:00 p.m. - Competitors and Spectators return to Gold Rock Lodge.

7:00 p.m. - Banquet, roast turkey with all the trimmings served in the spacious Lodge dining room.

8:00 - 12:00 p.m. - More movies and slides, refreshments, bull session, steam bath. The results of the first day's run will be announced.

Sunday

8:30 a.m. - Breakfast

9:30 a.m. - First rider leaves. Sunday's route covers 140 miles of roads and trails back to Toronto. The run will finish just north of the Glen Eagles Hotel on the Lansing Cutoff, 2 miles north of the Lansing Cloverleaf on Highway #401. Finishing time will be approximately 3:00 p.m. Results will be announced at the finish.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Accommodation - The following rates were only made possible by the co-operation and enthusiasm of the proprietor, Les North, himself a motorcycle enthusiast.

1. Cabin for Friday and Saturday nights
Breakfast Saturday and Sunday mornings
Turkey dinner on Saturday night \$6.00 per person

OR

2. Turkey dinner Saturday night
Cabin Saturday night
Breakfast Sunday morning \$4.00 per person

OR

3. Cabin Saturday night
Breakfast Sunday morning \$2.50 per person

Refreshments Friday and Saturday nights and sandwiches for Saturday and Sunday lunch will be available at a moderate extra charge. Steam bath is free. Accommodation is to be paid for on arrival at Gold Rock Lodge. To avoid disappointment we strongly advise that everyone planning to come fill in the Reservation Form below and mail it to the address given before September 10th. Clubs or other groups wishing to reserve a cabin as a group should enter collectively on a single form. Specify accommodation as No. 1, 2 or 3 as outlined above. No money need accompany the reservation form.

Entry Fee

Individuals - \$1.00 Teams - \$1.00 per team

This event is open to all holders of C.M.A. membership cards. Memberships available at the start - price \$2.00. Please indicate your intention to enter in the space provided on the reservation form. Competitors will start in the order in which their entries are received.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be run under C.M.A. sanction and rules, supplemented by those outlined below.

1. Organizers - British Empire Motor Club - Toronto

2. Route

The route as described above will be clearly marked by arrows and route cards indicating the time schedule, distance covered and direction at all pertinent intersections. Competitors will be required to average 30 mph over the whole of each day. (i.e. Time lost between any two check points must be made up before the next check to avoid a further loss of marks.)

3. Check Points and Marking

There will be several secret check points on the route. Marks will be deducted as follows: 2 marks for each minute early, 1 mark for each minute late. All times will be taken from the checker's watch to the nearest minute. Final scores will be determined by subtracting the total number of marks lost from 1000. All averages will be based on the mileages shown on the route cards. Maximum loss of marks at any one check will be 100. This penalty will also be awarded to competitors who miss a check or enter the check from the wrong direction. However, to be listed as a finisher a competitor must enter the finish check on both Saturday and Sunday within two hours of his scheduled arrival.

4. Classes

All competitors will compete in the same class.

5. Trophies

A replica will be awarded to the individual winner and also to the winning club team. Teams are to consist of three riders from the same club. One club may enter several teams but each rider may ride on only one team. All team entries must be made at the start.

6. Weather

This event will not be cancelled or postponed because of bad weather under any circumstances.
