An abandoned railway track which could be run at about 60-mph led to a section where a bridge had been removed.

Someone removed the warning signs and a rider had the unfortunate experience of flying 14 feet to the other side of a ravine.

'We've had incidents in the past years where signs were removed but no one ever did anything that could cause a rider to be killed," Dave Daniel, a Cord organizer said.

He said due to the death this summer of one of the Cord's founders, Les North, and because of lack of volunteer help, there might not be an event next year
