WELCOME TO THE 44th ANNUAL CORDUROY ENDURO

Please read this important information carefully

- 1. You have 90 (ninety) minutes each day, before 'houring' out instead of the usual 60 (sixty) minutes.
- 2. There will be a rider's meeting at the start of the event in Tommy Anderson Park at 11:30 a.m. Saturday. You are urged to attend as important information will be given out. Please ensure that no garbage is left in the Park on either day.
- 3. Local residents in their cars and four by fours use the fire roads frequently and you are advised to use extreme caution at all times.
- 4. Results will be available on Saturday afternoon at approximately 4:30 to 5:00 p.m. at Tommy Anderson Park.
 Results on Sunday will be at Caygeon Lanes on the south side of Highway # 36 just east of the junction of highway's # 649 and # 36. The results will be posted as soon as possible after the last rider has finished. There will be a cash bar and food available.
- 4. As you are all aware the availability of land on which to ride is becoming more scarce. We must do everything in our power to preserve what we have. The average speeds have been kept purposely low so that there is absolutely NO NEED to speed on the roads. The checks have been carefully placed so that speeders will be appropriately penalized.

Changes to <u>RULES</u> of which you may or may not be aware:

- 1. "Ladies Class" is a National Championship Class (entry form information is incorrect)
- 2. There is no longer any minimum distance between checkpoints and there is no minimum distance after gas stops to the next check.
- Q-56 If a rider checks in later than the time allowance after his original due time, he shall be scored to that check inclusive. No further checks after that will be included in his score.

Note: Also "Supplementary Regulations" (posted at sign in) permit a rider who does not finish all checks on Saturday and impounds his entered motorcycle on Saturday will be permitted to restart on Sunday and will be scored for finishing and results purposes. (If a Master or Expert, said rider will not receive national points)
